**Kuranda to Barron Falls Loop Experience
(Temporary Change in Operations)**



Skyrail will be operating a loop between Kuranda Terminal and Barron Falls from 19th August to 25th October (5 days a week, Wednesday–Sunday, boarding between 10:00 and 15:30) as part of Stage 1 of our upgrade project. This experience will last for approximately 1 hour, including time at Barron Falls Station, where guests will be able to enjoy the following activities and experiences:



Ranger Guided Tours

Join ranger-guided tours around Barron Falls / Dindin. Discover breathtaking rainforest scenery and unique ecology as our Rangers share stories of Indigenous heritage, pioneering history, and intimate knowledge of this remarkable environment.




Interpretive Displays

Discover Barron Falls' interpretive displays at our Rainforest Interpretation Centre, showcasing the Wet Tropics' diverse flora and fauna, and exploring the history and evolution of life on Earth through ancient plants and unique animal species.



Audio Guide App

Skyrail's Audio Guide App will immerse you in the ancient stories of the Djabuganydjì people, offering insights into how they have lived in harmony with this land for generations.



Historical Precinct

Step into the historical precinct at Barron Falls / Dindin, where restored machinery and haulage trolleys reveal the pioneering history of one of Queensland's first hydro-electric schemes.



The Edge Lookout

Take in stunning views of Barron Falls from our lookouts, including the spectacular Edge Lookout, and enjoy the dramatic cascade and lush rainforest scenery.
